Purpose:

Possible tasks:

- Assisting the Committee in generating a funding strategy and identifying the volunteer support required to achieve it.
- Assisting the Committee in suggesting and organising fundraising events throughout the anniversary year.
- Identifying grant-awarding bodies in the culture sector and generating bids on behalf of SDLC.
- Identifying potential sponsorship opportunities with local companies and organisations to raise funds and/or non-cash resources.
- Identifying opportunities to seek funding from high value residents of the Borough.

Location:

Home working

Occasional attendance at SDLC committee and/or funding group meetings held every other month at a location in central Croydon. Normally from 7pm to 9pm.

Time Commitment:

Variable - sometimes very little, at other times up to 1-2 days in a week (e.g. immediately before a big event). Hours spread out over the days, e.g. emails can be done at any time.

Support and Supervision:

You will work to the Chair of David Lean Cinema and be part of the cinema's fundraising group

Like all volunteers, you will be eligible for free entry to 10 screenings per year Opportunity to accept invites from film distribution companies to view screenings prior to their release
