The David Lean Cinema, Croydon Clocktower, Katharine Street, Croydon, CR9 1ET.


The David Lean Cinema is in the Croydon Clocktower learning and cultural complex (library, museum, CALAT) on Katharine Street. Our physical address is above. Use the entrance between the Town Hall clocktower and the Spread Eagle pub. For visitors with physical disabilities there is level access.

Signage has recently been improved, with banners and notice boards outside the building. Once inside, head to the left, go up the stairs. At the top turn left, past the entrance to the toilets, left again and go down the ramp to the Arts Cafe Bar – there is also a lift at the left-hand end of the atrium on the ground floor, the ramp is in front of you as you come out of the lift at level 1.

We are about 3 minutes walk from George St Tramlink stop.




BUS

A large number of bus routes have stops nearby. Transport for London's "spider" map of bus stops in central Croydon and the routes serving them can be seen here http://content.tfl.gov.uk/bus-route-maps/croydon-a4-070513.pdf. The best stops are Park Street (KJ,KH) or Croydon Flyover (KS) southbound, Katharine Street (KK,KL,KM) northbound. We are opposite bus stop KK. Southbound buses do not travel southbound along Katharine St. Fairfield Halls is a short walk away.


RAIL

By rail we are only an 8 minute slow walk from East Croydon station. See walking route below;



or if you don't want to walk, you can take buses 119, 197, 312 or 466.

From West Croydon Station it is only about a 10 minute slow walk, see walking route along High Street below;



or take bus 60, 109 or 250 from outside the station or routes 166, 264, 405, 407, 412 or 455 from stand B2 in the bus station.
